RESOLUTION NO. 504-08

**A RESOLUTION OF THE DURHAM CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING A FEE IN-LIEU
FOR TREE REPLACEMENT MITIGATION**

WHEREAS, when trees are removed from property, Ordinance No. 228-05 requires new trees be planted as mitigation; And,

WHEREAS, it is not always feasible or practical to plant mitigation trees on the same property from which trees are removed; And,

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 228-05 provides that the City Council shall establish an in-lieu fee on an annual basis that may be paid for the future planting of trees on city property rather than on the property from which trees are removed; And,

WHEREAS, the amount established should approximate the average cost of purchasing and planting an in-lieu tree,

NOW THEREFORE, the City of Durham resolves as follows:

1. The in-lieu fee shall be \$250.00 per tree that would otherwise be required to be planted as mitigation.
2. This fee shall be valid for one year from the date of this Resolution or until amended by future resolution.
