



Metro Local Share Survey

In 2019, Metro area voters passed a parks and nature bond that distributes funds to cities, counties, and other park providers for projects that matter to their communities. Durham’s share of the bond is \$310,665. There are strict guidelines as to how these funds may be used. One of the eligible uses is “maintaining or developing public access facilities at public parks and natural areas.” Additional criteria includes providing new or expanded access to nature, particularly in proximity to neighborhoods, centers, corridors, or transit, and improving accessibility and inclusiveness in developed parks to people of all abilities and backgrounds.

The City of Durham would like to use these funds to increase accessibility to Durham City Park by:

- Adding an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant sidewalk from Arkenstone Drive to the trailhead,
- Adding multilingual park signage,
- Adding ADA access to the play structure area,
- Installing a bike rack at the trailhead, and
- Repaving and re-curb the driveway and parking lot and adding an ADA accessible parking space.

The City of Durham would like to hear from you regarding these improvements.
